Vin Gupta, Chairman of World Education Foundation Participates in the GW Law School Conference in Hague and Paris

This foundation is the sponsor of joint intellectual property law curriculum between George Washington University Law School and the Indian Institute of Technology ("IIT"), Kharagpur, India. As India continues to grow into its role as a global partner in Software and Technology, these intellectual property law experts are needed to protect Indian intellectual property and also explore the possibility of outsourcing and intellectual legal work from U.S. to Indian Legal Scholars. The schools construction began in April of 2006 and now completed, provides a world-class education leading to a Post Graduate Degree in Law, and later, Doctorate programs.
